

1 SENATE BYLAW 1

2 BYLAWS BYLAW

(Effective May 17, 1983; Revised October 28, 2002)

Definition

1. A bylaw for CSUN shall be a legislative act prescribing procedure for CSUN Student Government by authority derived from the CSUN Constitution.

1. A Bylaws Committee shall be formed for the purpose of considering all proposed bylaws on the basis of relevance and necessity of each bylaw to the Constitution and existing bylaws;

1. The Bylaws Committee shall act according to the authority empowered to the committee by the Bylaws Committee Operating Policy, upon Senate approval of the Operating Policy and amendments to the Operating Policy.

Institution of Bylaws

Proposal, referral, submission:

Any CSUN member may propose bylaws to the Senate through a Senator;

The Senate shall refer all bylaws to the Bylaws Committee;

Only the Committee may submit proposals for approval to the Senate.

Proposals will be voted on the meeting following that of submission.

Classification of Bylaws

The Bylaws Committee shall classify all ratified bylaws according to a consecutive numbered series, to begin as Senate Bylaw #1;

All bylaws shall be titled according to subject matter;

All bylaws shall be cross-indexed according to titles and numbers.
