

## 1 SENATE BYLAW 8

### 2 CONSTITUTIONAL REVISION COMMITTEE

(Effective August 7, 1979; Revised June 16, 1981; March 2, 1998)

#### Purpose

The purpose of the Constitutional Revision Committee shall be to review all proposed

Constitutional amendments on the basis of relevance and necessity and refer them to the Senate.

#### Structure

Constitutional Revision shall consist of the following:

1. The chair, who must be a Senator;

1. At least four (4), but no more than seven (7) CSUN members, all of which must be Senators. At least two (2) members must also be members of the Bylaws Committee;

1. All members of this Committee will be nominated through the Senate.

#### Duties, Powers, and Responsibilities

##### The Chair:

Shall be nominated and appointed by the Senate;

Shall preside over all of the official meetings, he/she or the chair's designee, will maintain all agendas and minutes, and be responsible for the attendance records of the Committee;

The Chair shall assign excused/unexcused absences to members of the Committee.

Shall vote only to break a tie;

Shall undertake all charges deemed necessary by the full Committee;

Shall have the power to remove any member with three (3) or more absences.

##### The Vice Chair:

Shall assume the roll of the Chair in the temporary or permanent absence of the

Chair, and will assume all responsibilities of the position therein;

Shall retain full voting privileges;

Shall undertake all charges as deemed appropriate by the full committee.

The Committee shall present its findings to the Senate no later than twenty (20)

working days before the next general election.

The CSUN Senate by a two-thirds (2/3) vote shall be empowered to place the

proposed revision on the next general election ballot for student approval.
