

EXECUTIVE BOARD RIGHT TO DISMISS BYLAW

(Effective: May 7, 1987)

1 All CSUN Boards, Committees and Department Heads, whose chairs are nominated by the Executive Board and approved by the Senate, may be dismissed by the Executive Board at any time during their term of office.

The Executive Board shall not dismiss a Director or Chair until after all of the following have been met:

Notify the Director or Chair in writing of the reasons for the consideration of his or her dismissal;

Notify the Senate at least one (1) week prior to the Director or Chair's removal;

Guarantee due process through Executive Board hearings.

Dismissal of an appointed CSUN Board, Committee Chair or Department Head, by the Executive Board may be overridden by a two-thirds (2/3's) vote of the Senate Meeting immediately following that Official's dismissal.
