

**CO-DIRECTORS BYLAW**

(Effective: November 12, 1987; Revised: October 7, 1992)

**1 Should the Executive Board deem it necessary, Co-Directors may be nominated instead of a single Director for any service.**

When Co-Directors are appointed for a service, no Assistant Director shall be appointed for that service. The Executive Board shall not dismiss a Director or Chair until after all of the following have been met:

Division of Duties:

The duties and responsibilities of the Director of the service shall be divided equally between the Co-Directors in a manner of their choosing;

During any meeting of the service in which both of the Co-Directors are present, one of the Co-Directors shall function as the Director of the function while the other serves as Assistant Director for the duration of that meeting.
