

**CSUN ENTERTAINMENT AND PROGRAMMING BOARD**

(Effective: November 21, 1987; Revised: October 7, 1982 October 22, 2001)

**1 Purpose**

**2 The purpose of the Entertainment and Programming Board (E&P) shall be to obtain, schedule, administer, and publicize CSUN sponsored activities, entertainment, and social events.**

**Structure**

The E&P Board shall consist of the following:

The Director, who shall be nominated by the Executive Board and approved by the Senate;

The Assistant Director, who shall be selected as prescribed by Article IX, Section E, Item 1, of the CSUN Constitution;

At least 5 (5) but no more than thirty-five (35), CSUN members, at least (3) of whom must be Senators.

**Duties, Powers, and Responsibilities of the E&P Board**

**The Director:**

The duties of the Director shall be as those described in Article IX, Section D, of the CSUN Constitution;

The Director shall vote only to break a tie.

**The Assistant Director:**

The duties of the Assistant Director shall be as those described in Article IX, Section E, of the CSUN Constitution.

**The Board:**

**Budgetary Authority:**

The Board shall review the budget prepared by the Director;

All budgets must be approved by the Board prior to their submission to either the Ways & Means Committee, the Senate, or any other body as appropriated.

The Board may establish necessary subcommittees, whose chair must be a Board member;

The Entertainment and Programming Board shall establish an Operating Policy to be approved by both the E&P Board and the Senate.
