

1 SENATE BYLAW 55

2 STUDENT HEALTH ADVISORY BOARD

(Effective July 1, 1992)

The CSUN Executive Board shall designate a representative to be the Student Health Advisory Liaison to CSUN.

As a CSUN member, the representative will be required to maintain:

2.0 (on a 4.0 scale) per semester and cumulative G.P.A.;

Completion of six (6) credits per semester;

Adherence to the CSUN Conduct Code.

The representative shall be entitled to speak and participate in the Senate, Executive Board, Judicial Council, and all other meetings of CSUN entities as allowed by the respective presiding officers. In addition, the representative will be allowed to submit proposals through the Senate for consideration. The representative will, with the Executive Board and Senate approval, be allowed to form committees that report directly to the CSUN Senate. Each committee will consist of no more than five (5) CSUN members, one (1) of whom must be a Senator.
